ਖ਼ਾਲਸਾ ਕਾਲਜ ਅੰਮ੍ਰਿਤਸਰ ਇਕ ਗੌਰਵਮਈ ਇਤਿਹਾਸਕ ਸੰਸਥਾ ਹੈ। 1892 ਈ. ਵਿਚ ਇਸ ਕਾਲਜ ਦੀ ਸਥਾਪਨਾ ਸਿੱਖ ਕਦਰਾਂ-ਕੀਮਤਾਂ ਨੂੰ ਮੁੜ-ਸੁਰਜੀਤ ਕਰਨ, ਪੰਜਾਬੀ ਭਾਸ਼ਾ ਤੇ ਸਭਿਆਚਾਰ ਨੂੰ ਪ੍ਰਫੁੱਲਿਤ ਕਰਨ ਅਤੇ ਵਿਗਿਆਨ ਤੇ ਤਕਨਾਲੋਜੀ ਦੇ ਨਾਲ-ਨਾਲ ਆਧੁਨਿਕ ਸਿੱਖਿਆ ਦਾ ਪਸਾਰ ਕਰਨ ਦੇ ਉਦੇਸ਼ਾਂ ਨਾਲ ਹੋਈ। ਇਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਉਦੇਸ਼ਾਂ 'ਤੇ ਚਲਦਿਆਂ ਕਾਲਜ ਨੇ ਆਧੁਨਿਕ ਪੰਜਾਬ ਸਿਰਜਣ ਵਿਚ ਮੋਹਰੀ ਭੂਮਿਕਾ ਨਿਭਾਈ ਅਤੇ ਇਹ ਸਮੁੱਚੇ ਪੰਜਾਬੀਆਂ ਲਈ ਚਾਨਣ ਮੁਨਾਰਾ ਬਣਿਆ। ਅੱਜ ਖ਼ਾਲਸਾ ਕਾਲਜ ਇਕ ਆਟੋਨੋਮਸ ਕਾਲਜ ਵਜੋਂ ਪੂਰੀ ਕੌਮ ਦਾ ਮਾਣ ਹੈ। EducationWorld (EW) ਵੱਲੋਂ ਪੰਜਾਬ ਦੇ ਆਟੋਨੋਮਸ ਕਾਲਜਾਂ ਦੀ ਰੈਂਕਿੰਗ ਵਿਚ ਕਾਲਜ ਦਾ ਕਈ ਸਾਲਾਂ ਤੋਂ ਪਹਿਲਾਂ ਸਥਾਨ ਬਰਕਰਾਰ ਹੈ। ਨੈਸ਼ਨਲ ਅਸੈਸਮੈਂਟ ਐਂਡ ਅਕ੍ਰੈਡੀਟੇਸ਼ਨ ਕੌਂਸਲ (NAAC) ਤੋਂ ਚੌਥੀ ਵਾਰ 'A+' ਗਰੇਡ ਪ੍ਰਾਪਤ ਕੀਤਾ ਹੈ। ਇੰਡੀਅਨ ਕੌਂਸਲ ਆਫ ਐਗਰੀਕਲਚਰਲ ਰਿਸਰਚ (ICAR) ਅਤੇ ਪੰਜਾਬ ਸਟੇਟ ਕੌਂਸਲ ਫਾਰ ਐਗਰੀਕਲਚਰਲ ਐਜੂਕੇਸ਼ਨ (PSCAE) ਵੱਲੋਂ ਬੀ.ਐਸਸੀ. ਐਗਰੀਕਲਚਰ ਨੂੰ ਐਕਰੀਡੇਸ਼ਨ ਹਾਸਿਲ ਹੈ। ਬੀ.ਸੀ.ਏ. ਅਤੇ ਬੀ.ਬੀ.ਏ. ਕੋਰਸ AICTE ਤੋਂ ਮਾਨਤਾ ਪ੍ਰਾਪਤ ਹਨ। ਇਹ ਸਭ ਕਾਲਜ ਦੀ ਉੱਚ ਕੁਆਲਿਟੀ ਤੇ ਭਰੋਸੇ ਦੇ ਪ੍ਰਮਾਣ ਹਨ। ਇਸੇ ਅਟੁੱਟ ਭਰੋਸੇ ਕਰਕੇ ਖ਼ਾਲਸਾ ਕਾਲਜ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀਆਂ ਦੀ ਪਹਿਲੀ ਪਸੰਦ ਹੈ ਅਤੇ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀਆਂ ਦੀ ਗਿਣਤੀ ਪੱਖੋਂ ਵੀ ਪੰਜਾਬ ਦਾ ਨੰਬਰ ਇਕ ਕਾਲਜ ਹੈ।

ਕਾਲਜ ਦੇ ਸਾਬਕਾ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀਆਂ (ਐਲੂਮਨੀ) ਨੇ ਦੁਨੀਆ ਭਰ ਵਿਚ ਵੱਡੀਆਂ ਮੱਲਾਂ ਮਾਰੀਆਂ ਹਨ। ਇਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਨੇ ਅਕਾਦਮਿਕ, ਸਾਹਿਤਕ, ਰਾਜਨੀਤਕ, ਫੰਜ, ਖੇਡਾਂ, ਸਭਿਆਚਾਰਕ ਤੇ ਸਮਾਜ-ਸੇਵਾ ਦੇ ਖੇਤਰ ਵਿਚ ਕਾਲਜ ਦਾ ਨਾਮ ਰੌਸ਼ਨ ਕੀਤਾ ਹੈ। ਸੇ ਖ਼ਾਲਸਾ ਕਾਲਜ ਸਿਰਫ ਵਿਦਿਆ ਦਾ ਹੀ ਨਹੀਂ, ਸਗੋਂ ਖੇਡਾਂ, ਸਭਿਆਚਾਰਕ ਤੇ ਹੋਰ ਗਤੀਵਿਧੀਆਂ ਦਾ ਵੀ ਮੋਹਰੀ ਕੇਂਦਰ ਹੈ। ਇਸ ਦੀ ਸ਼ਾਹੀ ਵਿਰਾਸਤੀ ਇਮਾਰਤ, ਖੁੱਲ੍ਹੇ ਮਨ ਨਾਲ ਵੱਡਾ ਸੇਚਟ ਤੇ ਵੱਡਾ ਕਰਨ ਦੀ ਪ੍ਰੇਰਨਾ ਦਿੰਦੀ ਹੈ। ਇਸੇ ਕਰਕੇ ਖ਼ਾਲਸਾ ਕਾਲਜ ਦੇ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀਆਂ ਦੀ ਸੂਰਤ ਅਤੇ ਸੀਰਤ ਦੁਨੀਆਂ ਵਿਚ ਵੱਖਰੀ ਹੈ।

ਖ਼ਾਲਸਾ ਕਾਲਜ, ਗੁਰੂ ਨਾਨਕ ਦੇਵ ਯੂਨੀਵਰਸਿਟੀ, ਅੰਮ੍ਰਿਤਸਰ ਦਾ ਪਹਿਲਾ ਆਟੋਨੋਮਸ ਕਾਲਜ ਹੈ। ਯੂ.ਜੀ.ਸੀ. ਤੇ ਗੁਰੂ ਨਾਨਕ ਦੇਵ ਯੂਨੀਵਰਸਿਟੀ ਨੇ ਕਾਲਜ ਦੇ ਮਿਆਰ ਤੇ ਭਰੋਸੇਯੋਗਤਾ ਨੂੰ ਜਾਂਚ ਕੇ ਆਟੋਨੋਮਸ ਕਾਲਜ ਦਾ ਦਰਜਾ ਦਿੱਤਾ ਹੈ। ਇਸ ਤਹਿਤ ਕਾਲਜ ਯੂ.ਜੀ.ਸੀ. ਅਤੇ ਯੂਨੀਵਰਸਿਟੀ ਦੇ ਦਿਸ਼ਾ-ਨਿਰਦੇਸ਼ਾਂ ਅਧੀਨ ਸਮੇਂ ਦੇ ਹਾਣ ਦੇ ਨਵੇਂ ਕੋਰਸ ਸ਼ੁਰੂ ਕਰਨ ਤੋਂ ਲੈ ਕੇ, ਆਪਣੇ ਸਿਲੇਬਸ ਤੇ ਇਮਤਿਹਾਨਾਂ ਦਾ ਖੁਦ ਪ੍ਰਬੰਧ ਕਰਦਾ ਹੈ। ਆਟੋਨੋਮਸ ਸਿਸਟਮ ਅਧੀਨ ਵੀ ਕਾਲਜ ਦੇ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀਆਂ ਨੂੰ ਡਿਗਰੀ ਗੁਰੂ ਨਾਨਕ ਦੇਵ ਯੂਨੀਵਰਸਿਟੀ ਵੱਲੋਂ ਹੀ ਪ੍ਰਦਾਨ ਕੀਤੀ ਜਾਂਦੀ ਹੈ। ਕਾਲਜ ਵਿਚ 96 ਦੇ ਕਰੀਬ ਅੰਡਰ ਗ੍ਰੈਜੂਏਟ ਤੇ ਪੋਸਟ ਗ੍ਰੈਜੂਏਟ ਪ੍ਰੋਗਰਾਮ ਚੱਲ ਰਹੇ ਹਨ। ਇਹ ਲੜਕੇ-ਲੜਕੀਆਂ ਨੂੰ ਸਾਂਝੇ ਰੂਪ ਵਿਚ ਵਿਦਿਆ ਦੇਣ ਵਾਲਾ ਕੇ-ਐਜੂਕੇਸ਼ਨਲ ਕਾਲਜ ਹੈ।

ਕਾਲਜ ਵਿਚ 2023 ਤੋਂ ਹੀ 'ਨਵੀਂ ਸਿੱਖਿਆ ਨੀਤੀ-2020' ਲਾਗੂ ਹੈ। ਇਸ ਨਾਲ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀਆਂ ਨੂੰ ਚਾਰ ਸਾਲਾਂ ਬੈਚੁਲਰ ਡਿਗਰੀ ਤੇ ਇਸ ਉਪਰੰਤ ਇਕ ਸਾਲ ਵਿਚ ਮਾਸਟਰ ਡਿਗਰੀ ਕਰਨ ਦਾ ਮੌਕਾ ਵੀ ਪ੍ਰਾਪਤ ਹੋਵੇਗਾ। ਅਜਿਹੀ ਡਿਗਰੀ ਨੂੰ ਵਿਦੇਸ਼ਾਂ ਵਿਚ ਸਮਾਨਤਾ (equivalency) ਆਧਾਰਿਤ ਮਾਨਤਾ ਵੀ ਹੋਵੇਗੀ। ਨਵੀਂ ਪਾਲਿਸੀ ਅਨੁਸਾਰ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀ ਨੂੰ ਸਮੇਂ-ਸਮੇਂ ਐਗਜ਼ਿਟ ਲੈਣ ਦੀ ਵੀ ਖੁੱਲ੍ਹ ਹੈ। ਇਸ ਦੇ ਨਾਲ ਹੀ ਸਾਰੇ ਕੋਰਸਾਂ ਵਿਚ Credit Based Evaluation and Grading System (CBEGS) ਲਾਗੂ ਕੀਤਾ ਗਿਆ।

ਖ਼ਾਲਸਾ ਕਾਲਜ ਦਾ ਮੁੱਖ ਉਦੇਸ਼ ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀਆਂ ਨੂੰ ਅੱਜ ਦੇ ਸਮੇਂ ਅਤੇ ਨਵੇਂ ਯੁੱਗ ਦੀਆਂ ਲੋੜਾਂ ਮੁਤਾਬਕ ਸਿੱਖਿਆ ਪ੍ਰਦਾਨ ਕਰਨਾ ਹੈ, ਨਾਲ ਹੀ ਉਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਨੂੰ ਆਪਣੇ ਧਰਮ, ਇਤਿਹਾਸ, ਭਾਸ਼ਾ ਅਤੇ ਵਿਰਸੇ ਨਾਲ ਜੋੜਦੇ ਹੋਏ ਸਰਬਪੱਖੀ ਸਖ਼ਸੀਅਤ ਦਾ ਨਿਰਮਾਣ ਕਰਨਾ ਹੈ। ਵਿਦਿਆਰਥੀਆਂ ਦੀ ਹਰ ਮੰਗ ਤੇ ਸਮੱਸਿਆ ਦਾ ਤੁਰੰਤ ਹੱਲ ਕੀਤਾ ਜਾਂਦਾ ਹੈ ਅਤੇ ਉਨ੍ਹਾਂ ਨੂੰ ਹਰ ਸਹੂਲਤ ਮੁਹੱਈਆ ਕਰਵਾਈ ਜਾਂਦੀ ਹੈ।

Spacious in dimensions, the main college building is a masterpiece of architecture—a blend of Mughal, Rajput and Sikh Styles. The college campus covers an area of over 330 acres and provides the latest amenities of Higher Education. It is flanked by Chemistry, Computer and Physics blocks on the western side and Library, Sikh History, Postgraduate, Biotechnology and Canteen blocks in the eastern side. Sikh History & Research Department, that came into being in 1930 contains a reference library and a gallery of thousands of manuscripts, rare books, portraits and paintings of great historical significance and value.

The College is partly residential with five hostels namely Nabha, Faridkot, Hargobind, Jind & New Jind (for boys) and five hostels for girls providing accommodation to 1250 students. The campus also has within its premises a Gurudwara, Gymnasium, Nursery, Fruit Farm, Cricket Stadium, sprawling Playgrounds (Including Athletic Track, Basketball, Volleyball, Football, Hockey and Cricket Grounds) Swimming Pool, Fully Computerised Library, Career Guidance Cell, Placement Cell and Student Activity Centre. Infra structural development in the college is a regular feature. New Buildings of Administration Block, Agriculture, Commerce, Economics, Fashion Designing and Fine Arts Departments, Girls Hostel, Student Cafeteria have been constructed. Newly constructed washrooms for girl students and provision for R.O. filtered drinking water in the college and hostels are other highlights.



Divinity

The devout religious minded founders of the College attached highest importance to the study of religion and the cultivation of moral values among the youth. The College imparts regular religious guidelines, but there is no compulsion of any kind for non-sikh students. Prayers are held in the College Gurudwara in the morning and evening and resident members and students are motivated to attend the prayers. The Sikh students are also expected to partake 'Amrit' and participate in the celebrations of the Gurburabs and other religious functions.

The new session always begins with 'Ardaas Divas' to seek blessings of the Almighty. Examinations in Divinity are held periodically and scholarships and prizes are awarded to the best students. It is mandatory for Sikh students to tie turban. They are restrained from wearing patkas and caps in the College Campus. 'Nagar Kirtan' on the eve of Guru Nanak's birthday is a salient feature of the College since 1915. All the students and staff members participate enthusiastically in Nagar Kirtan. 'Dastaar Competition' is held in the month of April every year to motivate the Sikh students. With the initiative of the management, the College celebrates 'Avtar Purabs' of all the Ten Gurus. All faculty members and students participate in these celebrations.

College Library



The college library serves as a vibrant academic hub, fostering learning, research and intellectual growth among students and scholars. In keeping with this vision, the fully computerized library, equipped with a barcode system, provides excellent facilities to the scholars. The total number of books in the library exceeds 2,10,132. It has the distinction of housing one of the finest collections of books. College Library has got associate membership of 'INFLIBNET', which facilitates staff and students to have an access to Periodicals & Books on internet. **The library remains open on all working days from 8.00 am to 7.00 pm** There is a separate Research and Reference Section, Periodicals and Magazine Section and General Reading Section. **It subscribes to 69 Journals, 32 Magazines and 13 daily newspapers. Besides this it has procured 6257 back volumes of the subject journals for Post Graduate and Research Sections.** The Library collection is well classified, catalogued and kept on OPEN SHELVES in a systematic way. There is also a vocational guidance centre as an allied branch of the Central Library and sectional libraries for the departments of Agriculture, Biotechnology, Botany, Chemistry, Commerce, Computer Science, English, Physics, Physiotherapy, Political Science and Zoology under the charge of Professors concerned.

Library Conducts an Information, Literacy, User Education/Orientation Program for the new students in the beginning of the academic Session. Through this programme, efforts are made to familiarize every new member with resources, services, facilities, policies etc offered by the library. Besides this, these awareness programmes are also conducted when requested by users from time to time.

Students are issued books for a period of 15 days and may be re-issued at the discretion of the librarian for another fortnight but not exceeding a month in any case. A fine of Rupee one per day per volume is charged for each book kept beyond the specified date. Book lost, destroyed or disfigured by any user has to be replaced by the borrower or the user has to pay double the price to the satisfaction of the librarian. Reference books, texts or current periodicals are not issued except with the permission from the Principal. The librarian may recall, if necessary any book even before the expiry of the period. If the date of returning the book falls on Sunday or a holiday, the same can be deposited on the next working day. All the Post Graduate Departments have Departmental Libraries. S. Training and Placement Cell



Training and Placement Cell functions as a launching platform for the qualified candidates to make their dreams a reality. The Training and Placement Cell is directed by the Director Dr. Mani Arora and Assistant Director Dr. Anureet Kaur. The Training and Placement Cell prepares the students to face competitive examination and interviews through intensive training programs encompassing aptitude tests, group discussions, mock interviews, soft skills and body language. The Cell also assists the students in career planning and employment strategies. It invites reputed companies to the college and organizes campus placement. In the session 2025-26, various leading companies have actively visited for the campus placements which are currently in progress, resulting in an impressive number of successful placements. Maxicus KocharTech offered placement to 45 students of different departments. Indigo Airlines hired 4 students. 23 students got placed in AIM India Company and 12 students in CogniZen Innovations, all from commerce department. 2 BCA students got placed in renowned multinational company Genpact. 1 BCA student got selected in Cognizant and 1 got appointed in HDFC bank. Bhanguz Software Solution Pvt. Ltd. selected five students of BCA as software developer. RanBros Global recruited two students of computer science. ICICI bank selected 10 students as Relational Manager from various departments that include computer science, commerce and agriculture. Coca-Cola company offered employment to 7 students. 110 students on boarded as paid interns in various companies.

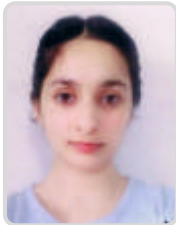

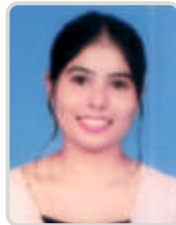

Candidates must have a Master's degree or an equivalent qualification with at least 55% marks or an equivalent CGPA [50% marks for SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/Differently-abled candidates] from Guru Nanak Dev University or any other recognised Indian or foreign university in the concerned or allied subject.

Candidates who have qualified UGC NET (including Category-III), UGC-CSIR JRF, INSPIRE Fellowship, SLET, GATE, GPAT, or are ICAR fellowship holders, Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship awardees, Nanak Fellowship awardees, or have passed M.Phil. from Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, or hold a valid Ph.D. Eligibility Certificate of the GNDU test, shall be exempted from the Ph.D. entrance test.

Candidates who are awarded fellowships directly by UGC, CSIR, INSPIRE Fellowship, Rajiv Gandhi National Fellowship, or any other recognized funding agency for pursuing Ph.D. may be enrolled at any time during the academic session.

Important Note: Candidates who have passed their qualifying (Master's) degree through Distance Education, ODL mode, lateral entry schemes, or from Central/State/Deemed/Private Universities, as well as those from regular mode, must ensure the equivalence of their qualification.

The equivalence may be verified from the Equivalence Book available on the Guru Nanak Dev University website (www.gndu.ac.in → [University Links](#) → [Information Desk](#) → [Registration Equivalence Section](#)) or by contacting the [Registration Branch, Administration Block, before seeking admission to the respective Ph.D. programme.](#)

If a candidate is admitted without verifying the equivalence of their previous qualification and is subsequently found ineligible, the candidate as well as the concerned department shall be held responsible for all consequences arising therefrom.

Ph.D. Eligibility Test: The Ph.D. Eligibility Test shall be conducted separately for various departments/subjects to fill available seats in the Ph.D. programme, in accordance with the prevailing ordinances of the College and Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar.

The minimum qualifying marks in the Ph.D. Eligibility Test shall be 55% (50% for SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/Differently-abled candidates).

The Ph.D. Eligibility Test is only a qualifying step for participation in the counselling process for admission. Fulfilment of other conditions, as prescribed under the prevailing Ph.D. ordinances of Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar, is mandatory. Qualifying the Ph.D. Eligibility Test does not, by itself, ensure admission to the Ph.D. programme.

- The validity of the Ph.D. Eligibility Test shall be two years and shall apply only to candidates who fulfil all other conditions for admission. A validity certificate shall be issued accordingly. Candidates who do not secure admission during the current session may avail themselves of this validity within the prescribed period.
- No exemption from course work shall be permitted.

The syllabus for the Ph.D. Eligibility Test shall be the same as that prescribed for UGC NET by the respective regulatory bodies. In subjects where NET is not conducted, the syllabus shall be based on the postgraduate (Master's level) curriculum.

The question paper will consist of two parts:

Part-I : It will be compulsory and common to all candidates. It will consist of 15 multiple choice questions of general aptitude, and will carry 15 marks.

Part II: This part will be subject-specific. Candidates will be required to attempt 40 objective type multiple choice questions, each carrying 1 mark and 9 short-answer questions (out of 20), each carrying 5 marks.

POST GRADUATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE



Khalsa College Amritsar was established in 1892 with the aim of disseminating value-oriented education in the field of Humanities, Agriculture, Science and Technology. In those days, besides Lyallpur Agriculture College (Pakistan), Khalsa College Amritsar was the only institution to offer degree in Agriculture in the region. The B.Sc. degree in the subject was affiliated to Panjab University, Lahore/ Chandigarh in 1931 and thereafter to Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar in 1971. In July 1967, the department was upgraded for post-graduation (M.Sc.) in Agronomy, Horticulture and Agricultural Economics. To keep pace with the increased demand for the course, post graduate streams (M.Sc.) in Soil Science, Vegetable Science & Entomology, Agricultural Extension & Communication, and Floriculture & Landscaping were added in recent time.

The curriculum and the syllabi of graduation and post-graduation in agriculture are revised from time to time as per the latest directions of I.C.A.R., (Indian Council of Agricultural Research), New Delhi and the degrees are awarded by Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar. In 2020, the college was accorded approval by State Council set up by Government of Punjab under the provision of PSCAE Act, 2017 to run B.Sc. degree programme in Agriculture. In 2024, B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture programme was approved for accreditation by ICAR, New Delhi.

The five storied ultramodern new Agricultural Block with state of Art Technology was inaugurated in 2015. RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ADMISSION

1. Subject combination course should be carefully checked to avoid subject clash.
2. Failed/detained/absentee students from any College/University Examination will not be admitted to the college in any case.
3. Such students whose result of the lower examination is notified as 'Result Later' by any Board or University except our college students, who appeared as regular candidates, will not be allowed admission to the higher class even provisionally. Students admitted provisionally to any class are required to submit the original certificate of the lower examination passed within 30 days of the admission for issue of University Registration Number. In case of non-compliance of the same, the admission of the student shall stand cancelled automatically and the dues paid by the student shall not be refunded except in case where college student has been admitted provisionally in higher class.
4. To maintain the high academic standards in the college the admission criteria for all classes will be laid down by the college authorities which will be either at par or above the minimum requirements of the G.N.D.U. The decision of the college authorities in this regard shall be final and the criteria may be revised from time to time during college admission period.
5. A student who joins the college and subsequently appears as private candidate forfeits the right to admission in the college in future.
6. A student can apply for more than one courses in one session. For each course he/she has to fill in a separate form. In case he/she is selected in more than one course, choice would be with the candidate. As and when the candidate deposits the fee for one course, the claim for the other course will be automatically forfeited.
7. All candidates will pay Registration Fee of Rs. 1000/- (Non Refundable) & adjustable in the fees later.
8. The candidates applying for the course, where the admission is based on Entrance Test, will pay Test Fee of Rs. 1200/- (non refundable).
9. The Principal reserves the right to refuse admission to any candidate, if he is satisfied that the refusal is in the interest of the college.
10. If a student makes a false declaration or conceals any information in the Admission Form, his/her admission to the college shall stand cancelled without any notice as soon as the false declaration or concealed information is detected. This case may be handed over to the police.
12. The Principal reserves the right to refuse admission to any candidate/student who was involved in strike/agitation or indulged in misconduct or indiscipline in the college/hostel in the proceeding year/years or on the basis of interview or otherwise where the Principal is satisfied that the refusal is in the interest of the college.
13. In case of serious misconduct—such as indiscipline, ragging, disruption of the academic environment, unauthorized absence from classes or tests, use of unfair means in examinations, or misuse of mobile phones—the Principal reserves the right to impose a heavy fine, cancel admission, and prohibit the student's entry into the college. Moreover, students are strictly prohibited from forming or participating in political or any such activities within the college premises.
14. The candidates with gap year after passing 10+2 or Graduation Degree will be granted admission in case the gap was due to exceptional circumstances, with due permission of Principal
15. A student must abide by the undertaking submitted (if any) at the time of admission, failing which his admission will be cancelled.
16. Every student needs to get registered for Academic bank of credit & also on anti ragging portal. The ABC ID and Anti Ragging reference number should be mentioned on the form.

FOR THE ATTENTION OF PARENTS AND STUDENTS

Regarding Conduct in College

1. Each student is issued an Identity Card which he/she must always carry and shall produce whenever asked by the college authorities. No student will be allowed to enter the College premises without the Identity Card.
2. Students with two wheelers will have to pay a parking fee. Four wheelers and Enfield Motorcycles are not allowed except with special permission from the Principal.
3. Don't scribble, put posters or litter the campus.
4. Attendance of the students in all college seminars, functions and celebrations is compulsory.
5. Keeping in mind the academic atmosphere of the college, the students (girls/boys) are instructed to wear decent clothes in the college. Taking selfies or making videos by the students in campus is strictly prohibited.
6. The notice regarding lecture statements of students falling short shall be displayed on the college Notice Board. Parents/Guardian of the students/wards are advised to contact respective Head of the Department in the month of September/March to know the status of the lectures attended by their wards. Any student falling short of lectures as prescribed by the University shall not be issued the Roll Number.
7. No visitors are allowed to meet students during the college hours.
8. Smoking & Drinking are strictly prohibited. Anybody found drunk or smoking in the College Campus will be immediately expelled.
9. Dispute, if any, will be subject to the jurisdiction of Amritsar Court only.
10. In case the student's identity card is lost, he/she may apply for duplicate ID card with the copy of FIR lodged with the police.
11. Ragging is strictly prohibited.

Note: The parents and the students are required to read the Prospectus carefully before signing the admission form. The responsibility of conduct as per the rules and regulations shall be upon the parents and the students and they shall be bound by same.

EXAMINATION FORM

1. It is mandatory for every student to fill and submit the examination form within a stipulated time period as specified by the Examination Branch, so as to enable him/ her to appear in final semester examination.
2. In case of Re-appear, the candidate should specifically fill the name of subject/paper.
3. In case of Re-appear, if the title of the paper remains same the student is to appear within current syllabus. Student appearing in any Re-appear should procure the syllabus from the respective department.
4. Delay in submission of Examination form will be subject to late fees as per University rules

RULES FOR THE ELIGIBILITY FOR FINAL EXAMINATION

1. A student is allowed for the final Examination only when he/she fulfils the lecture condition and his/her form is accompanied by the following certificate by the Registrar of the college.
 - a. That the student of Under Graduate Classes (Arts, Commerce, Sciences) has attended at least 75% of the full course of lectures in theory and practical separately, delivered to his/her class in each subject opted by him/her.
 - b. That the student of Post Graduate Classes has attended 75% of the full course of lectures in theory and practicals separately, delivered to his class in each subject/paper.
 - c. That the student of B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture Classes, B.Sc. (Hons.) Food Sci. & Tech., B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture, M.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture has attended not less than 80% of the full course of lectures in theory and practicals separately delivered to his/her class (as required by G.N.D.U. calendar).

Note: The student falling short of above stated required attendance shall not be eligible to appear in the final examination.

RULES OF SEMESTER EXAMINATION

- I. Courses having two semester duration:**
 - a. There shall be no condition for promoting a student from first semester to second semester.
 - b. In case a student fails to pass all the courses/papers within a period of two semesters (One year), he/she shall be given two consecutive semesters (One Year) more to pass.
- II. Courses having four semester duration (P.G. Classes)**
 - a) There shall be no condition for promoting a student from first semester to second semester .
 - b) However the student shall be promoted to the third semester only if he/she has passed at least 50% courses/papers of the first two semesters.
 - c) There shall be no condition for promoting a student from third semester to fourth semester.
 - d) In case a student fails to pass all the courses/papers within a period of four semesters (Two years), he/she shall be given four consecutive semesters (Two Years) more to pass.
- III. Courses having six semester duration:**
 - a) There shall be no condition for promoting a student from first semester to second semester
 - b) However, the student shall be promoted to the third semester only if he/she has passed at least 50% courses/papers of the first two semesters.
 - c) There shall be no condition for promoting a student from third semester to fourth semester.
 - d) However a student shall be promoted to fifth semester only if he/she has passed at least 50% courses/papers of the first four semesters.
 - e) There shall be no condition for promoting a student from fifth to sixth semester. After a period of six semesters the student shall be given a period of two consecutive years to pass.
- IV. Courses having eight semester duration:**
 - a) There shall be no condition for promoting a student from first semester to second semester.
 - b) However, the student shall be promoted to the third semester only if he/she has passed at least 50% courses/ papers of the first two semesters, but there will be no condition for promoting a student from third semester to fourth semester.
 - c) However, a student shall be promoted to fifth semester only if he/she has passed at least 50% courses/papers of the first four semesters. There shall be no candidate for promoting a student from fifth to sixth semester.
 - d) However, a student shall be promoted to seventh semester only if he/she has passed at least 50% courses/papers of the first six semesters.
 - e) There will be no condition for promoting a student from seventh to eighth semester.
 - f) After a period of eight semesters, the student shall be given a period of two consecutive years to pass.

Note:

1. No exemption shall be allowed beyond what is stated in the above ordinances.
2. Failing students shall appear in the examination in the regular semester examinations next year i.e., **reappear** for examination for an odd semester shall be conducted along with the next odd semester, and

even semester along with the next even semester and there shall be no special supplementary examinations.

3. In case of **additional** subject/subjects examination, **Improvement & Special Chance** in examination, University rules will be followed.
4. If 50% of the course/ papers required to pass involve a fraction, the fraction of the course/paper will be treated as a full course. For example, if in a year there are 13 courses in two semesters, the candidate will be required to pass minimum of 7 courses/ papers.
5. The **pass marks** for a course shall be 35% at UG and PG Diploma levels and 40% at PG level (Except BPT, Social Science, B.Sc. (Hons.) Agriculture, MPT & M.Phill). The student has to pass in theory and practical separately, excluding the internal assessments. Pass marks for a degree shall be 40% in aggregate at UG and PG Diploma and PG level. Re-evaluation shall be allowed as per ordinances.
6. The medium of instruction shall be as already mentioned in the ordinances.
7. **Maximum time allowed to pass a course is given as under:**

Course Duration	Maximum time to complete a Degree/Diploma
Four years	Six years
Three years	Five years
Two years	Four years
One year	Two years

If a student is detained in first semester due to shortage of lectures, he/she will not be eligible to seek admission in the next semester. He/she can get admission in the same semester in which he/she is detained in the next academic session.
8. Use of mobiles, blue tooth and other electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited in the examination. Any student found using electronic gadgets during examination will be punished as per college rules.
9. The student must report half an hour before the commencement of examination alongwith admit card (Roll No.) and ID Card.
10. If a student fails a paper due to internal assessment, he/she can improve the same by appearing in MST port attending special classes or both after depositing the required fees.

INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

An internal assessment of 25% is there in all the courses being run by the college. The internal assessment will be based on performance in House Examinations (MST), Attendance, Participation in co-curricular activities and classroom conduct and behavior of the student.

RULES REGARDING ATTENDANCE

1. The student shall be required to attend the lectures (Theory and Practical) as prescribed from time to time. As per University rules no lecture can be condoned on the basis of medical ground or any other leave.
2. The name of the student who remains absent without prior permission for more than a fortnight will be struck off from the college rules.
3. Lectures are to be counted up to the last working day before the commencement of the preparatory holidays.
4. A lecture will be considered as delivered even if the whole class is absent.
5. The Principal may condone the shortage in lectures as per the ordinances of Guru Nanak Dev University, applicable from time to time. While condoning the shortage, if any, the Principal will consider the conduct, behavior, unavoidable compulsions and general performance of the student. The student falling short of lectures shall be liable to be detained.

RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

For the Attention of Parents and Students:

As a Khalsa College student

- a. You have right to expect a teacher to take your classes on time, sincerely and effectively
- b. have the right to expect the teacher to grade and evaluate your progress regularly
- c. own any original work you have produced.

On the other hand as a student you are expected to

- a. reach the class on time and remain for the duration of the scheduled class.
- b. submit work that is your own
- c. submit the assignments for the evaluation of your progress in time.
- d. attend seminars, workshops or any other activity of the department.

It is in the interest of the students of Khalsa College that they should ensure that the learning environment is free from all behavior that would jeopardize the teaching and learning process. Such behavior might include, but is not limited to, missing classes, cheating, indiscipline in the class, plagiarism, uttering of false statement to obtain concessions and falsification of information .

The concessional rate of fee to a student belonging to Scheduled Caste/Backward Class is available only if the income from the all sources of the family is not more than 2,50,000 (per annum) in case of Scheduled Caste and not more than 1,00,000/- per annum in case of Backward Class. Such student will produce SC/BC Certificate (with income) and an affidavit on non-judicial stamp paper, duly attested by Executive Magistrate appointed by Punjab Govt. for attestation purpose along with a copy of Adhaar Card. Rs. 500/- (refundable) will be charged as security.
7. The fee once paid will be refunded as per rules.
8. For the refund of the security deposit, a student may apply within three months of completing his or her course. No claims will be entertained thereafter.
9. Keeping in view for the welfare of students the Principal can reallocate any amount realized under one head to another head.
10. No student can claim fee concession as a matter of right. The Principal may grant the fee concession on the basis of merit, economic condition, conduct of the students, achievement in sports and other extra curricular activities.

Student Welfare Insurance Scheme

Financial Assistance is given to students under Khalsa College Charitable Society Welfare Scheme. The provision for the affected students shall be as under.

- a) If any students met with an accident he shall be treated at College Dispensary, if the college doctor recommend for outside OPD, the student shall be reimbursed up to Rs. 2000/- subject to the provision of bills.
- b) Due to some fatal accidents or any other mishap where operation may be required Rs. 50,000/- shall be reimbursed to the student (subject to the provision of hospital bill)
- c) If the earning parents of the students die, the society shall bear his/her total College/School fee for 2/3/4 years (or till the culmination of the course in which he/she has taken admission) with the maximum limit of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Three lakhs only) for the whole duration period for the college student and Rs. 2,00,000 (two lakhs only) for the whole duration period for school students.

Special Merit Scholarships

1. Special Merit Scholarships will be awarded to top brilliant students on the basis of their merit in the admission/merit in the Board/ University Examination as per decision of college authorities from time to time.
2. A scholarship will be withdrawn immediately if an awardee indulges in indiscipline or violation of college rules or absents himself/herself in a class/house test.
3. Position holders in Sports and Extra Curricular Activities will be given concessions as per their achievements and to the Meritorious Students.

Rules for the Payment of College Dues

1. The date for the payment of the college dues for various classes will be fixed and notified by the Principal from time to time.
2. A fine will be charged for non-payment of dues in time.
3. Students absent from the College during the fee payment period must arrange to pay their fee within the due date.
4. Cheques will not be accepted for payment of College dues.
5. Non-payment of College dues within one month of the last day of payment will render the student liable to be struck off from College rolls. Such candidates may be re-admitted on payment of re-admission fee of Rs. 2000/-.
6. If a student does not get his/her name struck off from the colleges rolls by applying to the Principal, he will be treated as on the rolls of the College and the dues will be realised for the period of absence.
7. If a student leaves the college during any term he/she will have to pay the fees for the whole period of each term except in case of migration.
8. Extension in the date for payment of dues and permission to pay in installment may be granted in exceptional cases by the Principal and application for the same may be made before the expiry of the due date.
9. The student shall be penalised for absence from the college Functions/ Celebrations, as per notification.

GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIPS

1. **National Scholarship Scheme** : The students are granted scholarship every year on the basis of the Matric/ +2 and Graduate examinations. The number of scholarships to be given is decided by the Indian Govt. There is no income limit fixed for the Graduates who are granted scholarships on merit. The scholarship once granted continues till the student gets the degree. It is renewed every year on the basis of the progress shown by the student.
2. **State Competence Scholarship Scheme** : Under the State Competence Scholarship Scheme, the Punjab Govt. Grants the scholarships for General Education to the students on the basis of Plus Two and Graduate Examinations on merit. The student must be a resident of Punjab and have passed the examination from the institution under Punjab State. The student must seek admission in Punjab State.
Note: The Student placed in merit under the National and State Scholarship schemes have to submit their forms to the Head of the institutions conducting examination and the Principal of the educational institutions have to submit these forms after attestation to the Institutions conducting examination within a stipulated period.
3. **Scholarship to promote Hindi for Non-Hindi Speaking Students** : This is a center sponsored Scheme. Applications are invited from the colleges of the state and Scholarships are granted to students who are resident of Punjab State and have passed all examinations from Punjab.
4. **Scholarship for the Teacher's Children** : The Scholarship is granted to the children of the teachers every year on Merit. An application form for this scholarship can be obtained from the DPI (Colleges) Office, Punjab.
5. **Scholarship for Students of 1984 Riot Affected Families** : The Punjab State Grants the Scholarship every year to the students who belong to riot affected families (1984). An attested copy of the Red Card by concerned D.C. must be submitted along with the scholarship form.
6. **Scholarship for Construction Workers under State BOCW Board** : The State Building and Other Construction workers welfare board (BOCW) provides scholarship to the construction workers whose children are getting education. Punjab BOCW Board offers stipend for Rs 3000 to Rs 70000 per annum. For this the worker must be registered with the BOCW Board. The worker can apply through the State Labour. Department website or Umang App.
7. **Post Matric Scholarship for SC/ST,OBC and Minorities** : The detailed guidelines are given below

Note: One student can avail only one Scholarship at a time.

Guidelines for Financial Assistance to SC/ST/BC & Minority Students

The details of the financial assistance given to the students belonging to Scheduled Castes, Backward Classes and Schedule Tribes to complete their College/University Education is as follows:

1. **Post Matric Scheme of the Govt. of India:** Students belonging to Scheduled Castes who are permanent resident of Punjab State and are getting education in any part of India will be sanctioned stipends under this scheme provided the family income from all sources is not more than Rs. 2,50,000 per annum. Students will be given scholarships as per notification of Punjab Government.
2. **Special Grants for the Girls from Scheduled Castes** : Girls belonging to scheduled castes, whose parents are permanent residents of Punjab State and who are studying in the Colleges of Punjab will be sanctioned a grant provided the annual family income doesn't exceed Rs. 60965/-.
3. It is mandatory for SC/ST/OBC students to fill the form online.

Instructions for filling the Stipend form : The Form is available on the site www.punjab scholarships.gov.in (failing to fill form and submitting with college will disentitle the ste students from the benefits under the scheme.

1. The students belonging to SC/BC category should regularly check on the notice board for the necessary information.
2. The complete/filled forms should be submitted within fifteen days of admission failing which the student will not have any claim to seek such scholarship.
3. The attested detailed marks sheet of the previous exams should be submitted with the form.
4. It is necessary to submit the Income, Residence Certificate and Scheduled Caste Certificate duly attested along with the form.
5. The scholarship form must be attested by the Village Sarpanch/ Nambardar / Patwari / Gazetted Officer / MLA/ MP/ Municipal Commissioner.

Note : The scholarship can be withheld or cancelled by the Principal on the basis of unsatisfactory academic progress or immoral character or undesirable/indisciplinary activities. In case the information given in the caste and income certificates is found false/incorrect, the Principal can withhold or cancel the scholarship as well as the admission from college.

Student must attend 75% of lectures, other wise his/her scholarship form will not be forward to the Government.

Scheme of Post Matric Scholarship for students belonging to Minority Communities :

Govt. of India implemented Post Matric Scholarship Scheme for meritorious students belonging to economically weaker sections of minority communities so as to provide them better opportunities for higher education, increase their rate of attainment in higher education and enhance their employability. The scheme is implemented through National scholarship Portal (NSP). It is mandatory for all students to apply online on the website www.punjab scholarships.gov.in. Fresh SC/ST students should apply for free ship card on Dr. Ambedkar Scholarship Portal as per college notice, issued from time to time.
